Who will attend?

All awards with the exception of the Governor General's Medals in Architecture are presented at the President's Dinner and Awards Gala which is an important event at our annual Conference on Architecture. Conference delegates, awards recipients and their guests are in attendance.

The President's Dinner and Awards Gala is one of the social highlights of Conference. Delegates mingle during the cocktail reception before an elegant sit-down dinner and formal awards presentation. This year's event will include the highly anticipated announcement of the RAIC International Prize winner.

The Governor General's Medals in Architecture awards ceremony is a stand-alone event that is scheduled based on the Governor General of Canada's availability at Rideau Hall. The evening prior to the ceremony, a public lecture is presented in Ottawa.

GOVERNOR GENERAL'S MEDALS IN ARCHITECTURE (BIENNIAL)

These awards are administered jointly with the Canada Council for the Arts.

Being part of the publication is of great interest to those who value architecture and the quality of our cities, or those involved in the architecture profession.



ROUND TABLE EVENT | \$5,000

What: The National Urban Design Awards is a Canadian program established by the RAIC in partnership with the Canadian Institute of Planners (CIP) and the Canadian Society of Landscape Architects (CSLA) in 2006. The program showcases excellence in urban design, raises public awareness of the role of urban design in sustainability and quality of life in Canadian cities, and recognizes the contributions of individuals, organizations, firms, and projects.

Up to 12 projects may be awarded within the six different categories of urban design projects. One award will be bestowed for each category and an optional certificate of merit. The awards are part of a two-tier program held in cooperation with Canadian municipalities.

When: The recipient media release will go out in March 2026. The awards presentation will be held at the RAIC Conference in May 2026. An Urban Design round table will take place at Conference with the award recipients, including a Q & A, if feasible.

What: This program recognizes and celebrates recipients from seven separate awards, each with their own \$2,500 sponsorship opportunity. The awards are:

RAIC GOLD MEDAL

The highest honour that the Institute can bestow in recognition of a significant and lasting contribution to Canadian architecture. The honour recognizes a significant body of work demonstrated through either excellence in design, research, education, advocacy or other activities with a direct impact on the advancement of architecture in Canada. It considers the individual's breadth and scope of expertise; established presence within the public sphere, both in Canada and internationally; exemplary approaches to sustainability; support and advancement of equity, diversity and inclusion; and commitment to the future generation of architects.

ARCHITECTURAL PRACTICE AWARD

Recognizes a Canadian architectural practice that has consistently produced distinguished architecture. The award recognizes the achievements of the practice, considering at least five of the following core areas: quality of architecture; quality of professional services; innovativeness (such as methods and processes related to design, construction and/or practice); contributions to the profession (including professional institutions and/or associations); research and teaching; exemplary approaches to sustainability; support and advancement of equity, diversity and inclusion; and commitment to the future generation of architects through supports such as mentorship, training opportunities and providing a path to licensure.

EMERGING ARCHITECTURAL PRACTICE AWARD

Recognizes an emerging Canadian architectural practice that shows exceptional promise for contributing significantly to the future of architecture. The award recognizes the early career achievements of the practice and considers: quality of architecture; innovativeness (such as in methods and processes related to design, construction and practice, exemplary approaches to research and teaching, sustainability, or the support and advancement of equity, diversity and inclusion); and current—as well as potential for future—leadership within the profession.

RAIC ADVOCATE FOR ARCHITECTURE AWARD

This award celebrates an individual, or collective of individuals, who has acted as a public champion for the advancement of Canadian architecture through their advocacy, patronage, and/or other forms of support. Candidates may include clients or patrons, educators, public servants, architects, allied professionals and others. It considers exemplary approaches to sustainability, as well as the support and advancement of equity, diversity, and inclusion. The award recognizes long-term commitment to the profession at an international, national, regional or local level.

RAIC RESEARCH & INNOVATION IN ARCHITECTURE AWARD

This award recognizes an architect, architectural practice and/or academic researcher who has demonstrated excellence in research and/or innovation in architectural practice, technology, or pedagogy. It celebrates initiatives that advance professional practice and/or disciplinary knowledge, and considers exemplary approaches to sustainability, as well as the support and advancement of equity, diversity, and inclusion.

RAIC ARCHITECTURAL JOURNALISM AND MEDIA AWARD

This award recognizes an architect, architectural practice or individual that presents a narrative about architecture which promotes public understanding and awareness of architecture, the role of architects and their impacts on society, and/or the value of design and design excellence. The entry can range from a single significant contribution to a collection of work.

PRIX DU XX^E SIÈCLE

The Royal Architectural Institute of Canada (RAIC) and the National Trust for Canada aim to promote public awareness of significant modern Canadian architecture from the 20th century. The Prix du XX° Siècle celebrates design quality and enduring excellence, recognizing the design of the original architect(s) and/or firm(s) and the on-going stewardship of the building's owner(s). An expert panel will be established, and maintained, by the RAIC and National Trust for Canada. Any existing building built within the 20th century is eligible for the Prix.

When: All seven awards are presented at the RAIC President's Dinner and Awards Gala, at the RAIC Conference on Architecture.
